



PASTA FACTORY, BUTCHER, AND CASTLE

Discover the charm of the hilltop village of Lari, a hidden gem in the Terre di Pisa, with a half-day tour filled with history, flavors, and local traditions. The journey begins with a visit to a historic artisanal pasta factory, run by the same family for generations. Meet the passionate artisans and learn about the traditional methods that make each pasta creation unique. Next, explore the Castello dei Vicari, a 14th-century castle overlooking the town center. A guide leads through its historic halls, including medieval prisons, old courtrooms, and frescoed rooms, ending in the inner courtyard adorned with coats of arms of Tuscany’s most influential families. The tour continues at a local butcher shop, where the secrets of crafting prosciutto and salami using traditional techniques are revealed. Enjoy a tasting of these authentic cured meats made from natural ingredients. A unique experience awaits in an ancient cheese grotto, where a special blend of cow, goat, and sheep milk cheeses is aged for months. Sample these delicious cheeses as an aperitivo before heading to a town-center restaurant to enjoy two dishes featuring artisanal pasta as the star ingredient. A journey of history, flavor, and authenticity, offering a true taste of Lari through its culinary and cultural treasures.
