Your experience concludes with a visit to a prestigious Italian cheese-ageing house, home to masterpieces such as Parmigiano Reggiano, Pecorino, Bitto, Gorgonzola, and the prized Bettelmatt.

Explore the atmospheric cellars and enjoy a wine and cheese tasting, with the opportunity to shop for select local products.
