



THE UFFIZI GALLERY TOUR

Discover the extraordinary history of the Galleria degli Uffizi with a private tour led by a professional guide specialized in Florentine art history. A journey through centuries of beauty that began in 1560, when Cosimo I de' Medici commissioned Giorgio Vasari to design an imposing building intended to house the administrative offices of the Florentine State.

Just a few years later, the famous Vasari Corridor was created — the remarkable elevated passageway that crosses the Ponte Vecchio, passes alongside the Church of Santa Felicita, and leads to Palazzo Pitti and the Boboli Gardens: a secret route designed to protect and celebrate the Medici dynasty.

It was under Francesco I de' Medici that the collection reached its peak, with the creation of the refined octagonal Tribune, conceived to display the family's most precious masterpieces. In 1769, Pietro Leopoldo of Lorraine opened this immense heritage to the public, transforming the Uffizi into one of the first modern museums in Europe.

Today, the Gallery preserves thousands of masterpieces, from medieval works to the great masters of the Renaissance and beyond, alongside ancient sculptures, miniatures, and rare objects.

Enjoy an engaging and refined experience, where history, power, and artistic genius come together in one of the world's most iconic museums.
