

Herculaneum is a truly unique destination: an ancient Roman city buried under more than twenty meters of volcanic deposits following the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD.

Rediscovered centuries later, thanks to the Bourbon dynasty and a chance find near the ancient theater, the site remains remarkably intact, offering a vivid glimpse into everyday life in Roman times.

During the tour, you will have the opportunity to admire the exceptional state of preservation of the buildings: carbonized wooden structures, bronze elements, facades, and frescoes that have survived remarkably well.

The route allows you to explore not only the urban layout and residential architecture but also the distinctive styles of Vesuvian painting and the construction techniques of the era.

Among the most significant highlights are the College of the Augustales, the Thermae, the House of Neptune and Amphitrite, the Samnite House, and the evocative beach, where more than three hundred people sought refuge during the eruption. Every stop tells an authentic and moving story of life in ancient Herculaneum.

This tour is not just a visit—it is a truly Italian experience: traveling through the heart of Campania, discovering Roman heritage, and immersing yourself in the landscapes and culture that make Italy so unique.
