



ORTIGIA TOUR AND STREET FOOD

An engaging experience discovering Ortigia, the historic and Baroque heart of Syracuse, where history, art, and gastronomic traditions blend into a unique atmosphere.

The guided tour unfolds along the island's charming narrow streets, allowing visitors to admire some of its most representative landmarks: the magnificent Cathedral of Syracuse, built on the site of the ancient Doric Temple of Athena and an extraordinary example of historical continuity; the evocative Fountain of Arethusa, wrapped in myth and legend; and the Temple of Apollo, one of the oldest testimonies of Greek presence in Sicily.

The itinerary continues with a visit to the lively Ortigia market, an authentic place full of colours, aromas, and voices, where daily local life can be observed and the area's products and culinary traditions can be discovered.

At the end of the tour, a tasting of selected Sicilian specialities is included, such as PDO cheeses, PDO cured meats, artisanal preserves, and vegetables prepared according to traditional recipes, like caponata, all accompanied by a glass of local wine.

An ideal tour to experience Ortigia through its millennia-old history and its renowned food culture, in an authentic and evocative setting.
