



A fascinating excursion combining cinema, landscapes and Sicilian traditions, inspired by the places made famous by Francis Ford Coppola’s masterpiece “The Godfather”.

The experience begins with a journey to Castelmola, a charming medieval village in the province of Messina, perched on a rocky outcrop overlooking the Ionian Sea. From here, guests can enjoy breathtaking panoramic views stretching along the coastline and towards Mount Etna. A stop at a local bar is included to sample a traditional local speciality: almond wine.

The tour then continues to the picturesque villages of Savoca and Forza d’Agrò, authentic Sicilian gems chosen as locations for some of the film’s most iconic scenes. In Savoca, visitors can enjoy the famous Bar Vitelli, where a refreshing lemon granita is served, and the Church of Santa Lucia, the setting for the memorable wedding scene between Apollonia and Michael Corleone.

The visit to Savoca and Forza d’Agrò is not merely a nostalgic tour of a film set, but a journey through Sicilian culture, history and popular traditions. Walking through narrow streets, small squares and timeless views offers the opportunity to discover the authentic soul of traditional Sicilian villages.
