

Discover Mount Vesuvius, the most iconic volcano in the world and the undisputed protagonist of the Gulf of Naples. A majestic place where nature reveals, step by step, its ancient story carved in lava, rock, and breathtaking landscapes.

The adventure begins at 1,000 meters above sea level, where the air turns crisp and the silence of the mountain welcomes visitors.

From here, the ascent towards 1,175 meters begins: an exciting route winding through panoramic bends that offer unique views of the gulf and the incredible lunar-like scenery surrounding the crater.

Along the climb, the trail is dotted with fascinating natural lava-stone formations — powerful reminders of the volcano's activity. Your gaze stretches all the way to the imposing Monte Somma, the original ancient volcano, separated from Vesuvius by the evocative Valle del Gigante: a landscape that tells the story of the earth's evolution.

You will then follow the most scenic path of the Vesuvius National Park, the one leading to the "Gran Cono," the main crater of the volcano.

The trail runs along the crater rim until reaching the Capannuccia: here, before the immensity of the crater, time seems to stand still. It is a moment of pure wonder—an intimate encounter with the most powerful side of nature.

After descending, the experience continues with a stop dedicated to the authentic flavors of the region: a tasting of local typical products that embody the volcanic soul of this fertile and generous land.
