Founded in 1089 by Count Ugone, this monastery has been a landmark of religious, political, and cultural life for centuries, shaped by the Camaldolesi monks who lived and worked here.

During this exclusive tour, you'll walk through the ancient convent and follow the evolution of the monastery—from its medieval origins to its transformation into the summer residence of the Bishop of Volterra in the 15th century.

The enchanting late 11th-century Romanesque church will be opened especially for us, offering a rare and intimate glimpse into Italy's sacred past.

The experience continues in the more contemporary part of the estate, home to the olive mill and winery. Here, you will uncover the secrets of authentic Italian extra virgin olive oil and take part in a blind tasting designed to sharpen your senses and deepen your appreciation for this pillar of Italian cuisine. You will then explore the winery and enjoy a tasting of six distinct Italian wines, paired with a traditional Tuscan light lunch—an elegant union of local flavors, history, and craftsmanship.

To conclude, you'll savor an exclusive tasting of the estate's grappa—or vinsanto if you prefer a gentler finish—paired with classic Tuscan cantuccio cookie.

A perfectly Italian finale to a journey celebrating authenticity, heritage, and the timeless pleasure of good food and wine.
