



PECCIOLI E GHIZZANO ART, WINE AND GELATO

Valdera is a captivating destination where history, art, and tradition blend seamlessly. This experience explores two charming Tuscan villages, each offering a unique perspective on the region.

The journey begins in Ghizzano, a small hilltop village enriched by contemporary artworks from Alicja Kwade and David Tremlett, set against its thousand-year-old history.

An external visit to the historic Venerosi Pesciolini Villa, home to the same noble family since the 14th century, adds aristocratic charm. A stroll through the elegant Italian gardens and an aperitivo with organic estate-produced wine complete the visit.

Before reaching Peccioli, a stop at a striking contemporary winery combines art and winemaking. The experience includes a guided visit, a tasting of at least four wines, and a light lunch thoughtfully paired with each course.

The tour continues in Peccioli, where modern art installations by Hidetoshi Nagasawa, Daniel Buren, and Jeppe Hein contrast beautifully with historic landmarks such as the 12th-century church. The Palazzo Senza Tempo and its suspended terrace offer breathtaking views over the Tuscan countryside. A gelato tasting at a local pastry shop provides a sweet and authentic finale to this cultural journey.
