



ORGANIC MONTALCINO & LOCAL TASTING

On the hills of Montalcino, there is a place where wine is born from the meeting of history and landscape. Podere Pociano, a 17th-century palace and former convent, welcomes guests in a timeless setting, overlooking the estate’s vineyards that define its very soul.

The experience takes place on the panoramic terrace, where guests can enjoy the view over the rows of vines and a slower pace of life. The guided tasting features five representative wines: IGT Pociano, Rosato, Rosso di Montalcino, Brunello di Montalcino, and a Brunello Riserva or Selection. Each glass is presented with attentive technical notes highlighting the vintage, the terroir, and the production choices behind it.

The tasting is accompanied by a generous platter, including bruschetta with the estate’s own extra virgin olive oil, fresh and aged cheeses, and a selection of Tuscan cured meats, creating a natural balance between wine and local flavors. A short tour through the vineyards allows guests to connect directly with the land and understand the origin of what they taste in the glass.

Children are also catered for, with organic juice and the opportunity to explore the educational farm, interact with the animals, and enjoy the estate’s green spaces, while adults can indulge in the pleasures of tasting, listening, and quiet contemplation.
