In the afternoon, head to a winery known for its exceptional Super Tuscan wines, situated in Northern Maremma, about 180 meters above sea level. Given the vicinity of the sea, their soil varies from pure calcareous and marine origin, to stony and arid of magmatic-volcanic origin and some deep-sea sedimentary clay. This gives the possibility to create unique balanced, structured and quality wines. Explore the vineyards and cellars, and enjoy a tasting of the estate's finest wines.
