

Start your day by visiting a local pasta factory that began its family business in the 19th century, followed by a visit to a wine estate with a heritage dating back to the 16th century. In Italy, pasta is a staple, and for high-quality pasta, it's important to discover producers who respect the natural ingredients they use and their meticulous processing methods.

First, explore the world of pasta at the pasta museum, where you can admire old machinery and tools once used in pasta production and discover the various production phases. Established in 1860, this family-run business, now in its fifth generation, continues its traditions. Enjoy a delicious lunch at the factory's restaurant, featuring pasta dishes and a typical dessert.

Next, visit a winery where intellectuals, artists, and cultural figures from Italy and abroad have visited over the years. The estate is connected to historical figures, including the Florentine Capponi family, writer Alessandro Manzoni, actor Marcello Mastroianni, and even the Agnelli and Piaggio families in the 1950s. Explore the private historical villa, Renaissance Garden, modern cellars, and captivating historical wine cellars. Enjoy a tasting of three distinctive wines made from Sangiovese and Syrah grapes, and take home a silk-screened wine glass as a keepsake.
