

An unforgettable day exploring two of the most famous medieval villages in the Valdera region: Peccioli, winner of the 2024 Borgo dei Borghi award, and Lajatico, the birthplace of Andrea Bocelli.

Peccioli is a charming medieval village that features numerous contemporary art installations integrated into the historic architecture. Works by artists such as Remo Salvadori, Hidetoshi Nagasawa, and Daniel Buren can be admired, along with the Romanesque church of San Verano. The Palazzo Senza Tempo, recently restored, offers a stunning terrace overlooking the surrounding hills. Lajatico, known for the famous Teatro del Silenzio, hosts an annual concert by Andrea Bocelli, attracting thousands of visitors. During the tour of the village, explore its history and enjoy contemporary art installations that change every year. The day ends with a walk to the Teatro del Silenzio and a toast with a glass of prosecco produced by the Bocelli family.
