

If you've already visited Pisa, uncover a hidden gem just outside the city with a visit to the Charterhouse of Pisa, founded in 1366 by Carthusian monks and inhabited until 1977. This historic site, transformed in the 17th century, showcases stunning Baroque architecture. Wander through the impressive church, beautifully decorated chapels, and uncover the secrets of the monks' lives.

After the Charterhouse tour, head to Buti or Vicopisano to taste the renowned extra virgin olive oil from the hills. Learn to distinguish the superior quality of local olive oil, produced in the Pisan Mountains, famous for their exceptional oils. Enjoy a traditional Tuscan lunch in a charming taverna, and then explore the historic streets of Vicopisano. Admire the town's tower houses, the clock tower, the Brunelleschi Fortress, and an enchanting medieval church, capturing the timeless beauty of the Middle Ages.
