



WINE & OLIVE OIL AT THE ANCIENT ABBEY

The motto for this tour is “From monks to wines: a journey with a taste of history.” Experience a visit to one of the oldest estates in the region, a nearly 1000-year-old Abbey nestled in the quaint town of Morrone near Terracina. Established in 1089 by Count Ugone, this monastery has been a centre of religious, political, and civil life for centuries, guided by the Camaldolese monks. During the exclusive visit, explore the former convent and trace the monastery's evolution, from its origins as a convent to its transformation into the summer residence of the bishop of Volterra in the 15th century. The enchanting late 11th-century church will be opened for this occasion. Following the monastery visit, head to the more modern section of the farm, the winery and olive mill. Learn about the production of extra-virgin olive oil and enjoy a unique blind tasting, refining the ability to discern the nuances in olive oil quality—an experience that will forever change the way olive oil is appreciated. Discover the secrets of the winery and enjoy a tasting of 6 distinct wines. A delightful Tuscan light lunch accompanies the wine tasting, creating a harmonious blend of history, excellent wines, flavorful olive oil, and delicious food. This tour offers an unforgettable combination of past and present, an experience not to be missed.
