

Alta Mora Etna Bianco is produced from 100% Carricante grapes, grown on the volcanic slopes of Mount Etna. The vineyards lie at high elevations — typically between 600 and 900 meters above sea level — on mineral-rich volcanic soils. This unique terroir, with cool climate influence and strong diurnal temperature shifts, gives the wine striking freshness and minerality.

Grapes are hand-harvested to ensure optimal integrity and quality.

After harvesting, the grapes are gently pressed and the must decanted, then fermented in stainless steel at a controlled temperature of around 18–20 °C.

The wine is then aged for about 4 months on fine lees in steel tanks, before

bottling.
The result is an elegant, mineral white wine, with intense and complex aromas of green apple, citrus, white flowers and flinty stone. On the palate it is fresh and saline, with a refined structure and excellent clarity.
