



ETNA ROSSO ALTA MORA

Etna Rosso Alta Mora is made from 100% Nerello Mascalese, one of the most iconic native grape varieties of Mount Etna. The grapes come from several historic crus located in the municipality of Castiglione di Sicilia — Contrada Verzella, Contrada Guardiola, Contrada Feudo di Mezzo, and Contrada Solicchiata — areas renowned for producing red wines of remarkable elegance and depth.

The vineyards, trained both in espalier and alberello systems, lie at elevations between 600 and 800 meters above sea level. The volcanic soils and significant diurnal ranges contribute to excellent concentration and aromatic complexity. Harvesting is done manually in crates during the second ten days of October, ensuring optimal ripeness and berry integrity.

Vinification includes destemming, followed by 12 days of maceration at 28°C to extract aroma, color, and refined tannins. After gentle pressing, the wine undergoes malolactic fermentation in stainless steel, then matures in large 25-hectoliter oak casks, which enhance balance without overshadowing the wine’s volcanic character.
