



IL FAR WEST D'ABRUZZO: UN'AVVENTURA SPAGHETTI WESTERN

Set off on an exciting e-bike adventure from the charming village of Santo Stefano di Sessanio, exploring some of Abruzzo's most breathtaking landscapes. Ride along a scenic provincial road, ascending to the picturesque Lago di Racollo, with a brief stop at a mountain refuge at 1,600 meters above sea level. Heading east, enter the stunning Campo Imperatore plain, often referred to as "Abruzzo's Little Tibet," where expansive views and cinematic landscapes await. Explore the Scoppaturo Canyon, famously featured in classic Spaghetti Westerns of the '70s and '80s, before reaching Fonte Vetica. Along the way, enjoy a stop at the rustic Ristoro Mucciante, a local gem nestled beneath Monte Camicia.

The journey continues westward, with the majestic Gran Sasso in view and the Monti della Laga framing the horizon. Descend along a panoramic route offering sweeping views of the Sirente-Velino range and distant Maiella peaks, concluding back in Santo Stefano, where you can enjoy an optional hearty lunch. An unforgettable adventure in the heart of Abruzzo!
