



Alghero, the only Catalan city in Sardinia, is an essential destination during your holiday. This charming town, overlooking the northwestern coast of the island, is often referred to as "Barceloneta", as it was once conquered and inhabited by the Catalans for four centuries. You'll explore the heart of the historic citadel, still encircled by walls and ramparts originally constructed by the Genoese in the 12th century, then fortified by the Catalans after they officially took control in 1353. As you wander through its streets, you'll feel immersed in the distinctive Catalan atmosphere, with many palaces and buildings that beautifully preserve its rich history. Your visit will take you to the majestic Cathedral of Santa Maria and the Church of San Francesco, where the ancient cloister remains home to monks to this day. As you stroll along the narrow cobbled streets and the main thoroughfare of the old town, you'll be treated to breathtaking views of the sea, particularly stunning at sunset.
