

This tour begins in the heart of Gallura, in Luogosanto, a village known for its 22 sanctuaries, which give it a deep spiritual significance.

You will explore the historic center, characterized by granite buildings, and visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Luogosanto. Since the 18th century, this basilica has held the rare privilege of a holy door, which, like St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican, opens every seven years for a year-long period of plenary indulgence. Next, just outside the village, you will visit the hermitage of San Trano and San Nicola, perched on a panoramic hill offering breathtaking views of Luogosanto. This serene retreat, once home to two 4th–5th century hermit saints, emanates an atmosphere of profound peace.

The experience concludes in the heart of Luogosanto with a tasting of local delicacies paired with regional wines. Among them, you will savor Vermentino di Gallura, Sardinia's only DOCG wine, a distinctive white wine enriched by the area's granitic soil and ancient minerals.

DURATION: 2.30 h + transfer time.
