To this day, this unique wine remains a distinctive feature of the region, with many local wineries making it their flagship product. Today, thanks to strict regulations governing cultivation and winemaking, this wine stands as the pride of local wineries, which will host you for an unforgettable experience and a true taste of the heart of the island. Accompanied by a local guide, you will visit a Vermentino winery and learn about its most distinctive aspects. Each tasting will be paired with carefully selected tastes of local products, expertly chosen by the chef. If you prefer red wines, no worries! Each winery also produces excellent local reds, offering you the chance to discover another side of Gallura's rich winemaking heritage.
